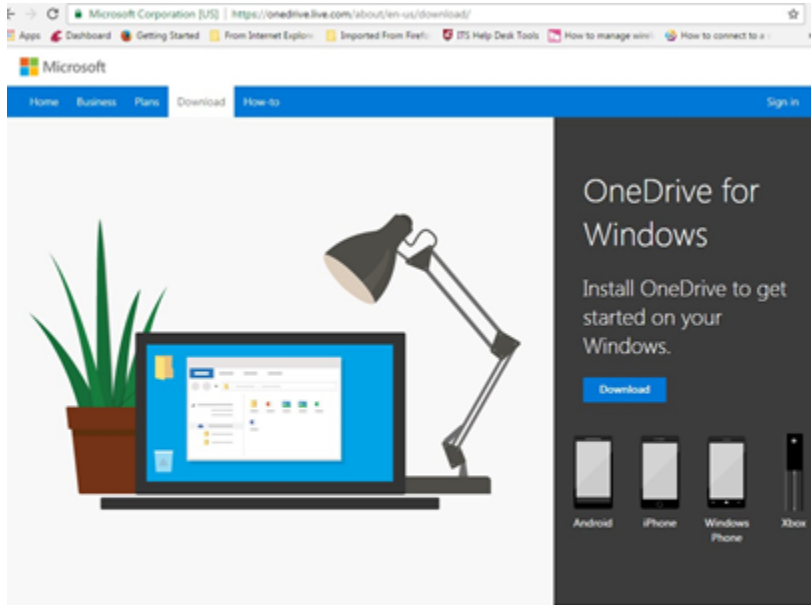

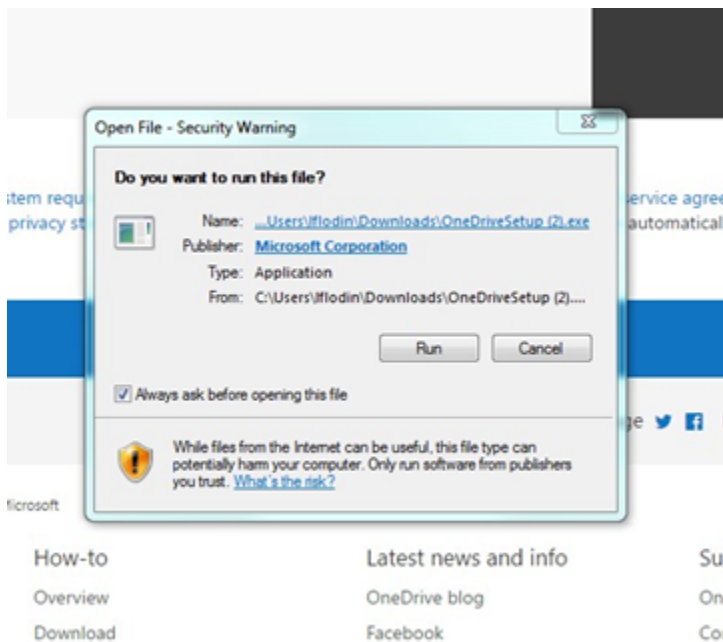
OneDrive: How to Install OneDrive on Windows

How to install OneDrive on Microsoft Windows.

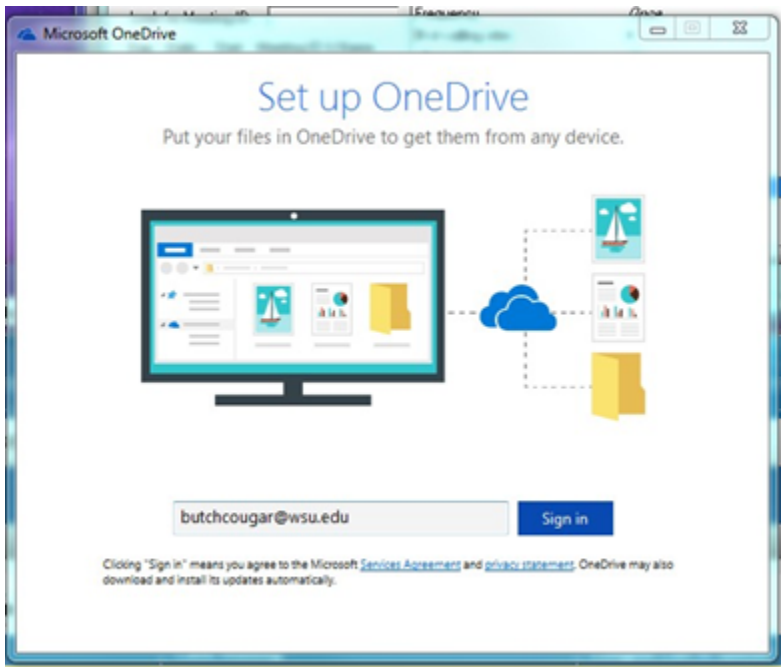
1. Go to <https://onedrive.live.com/about/en-us/download/> and select the download option.



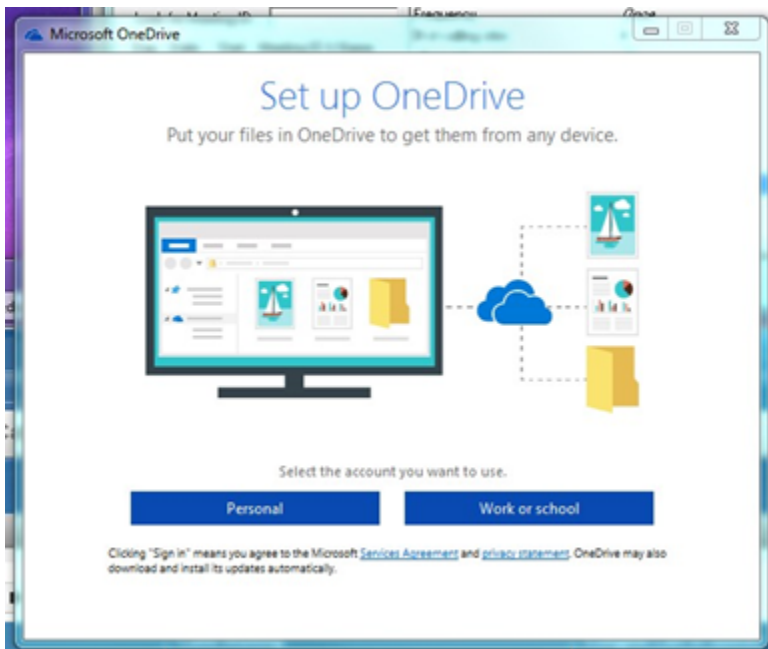
2. Select **Run** from the install prompt.



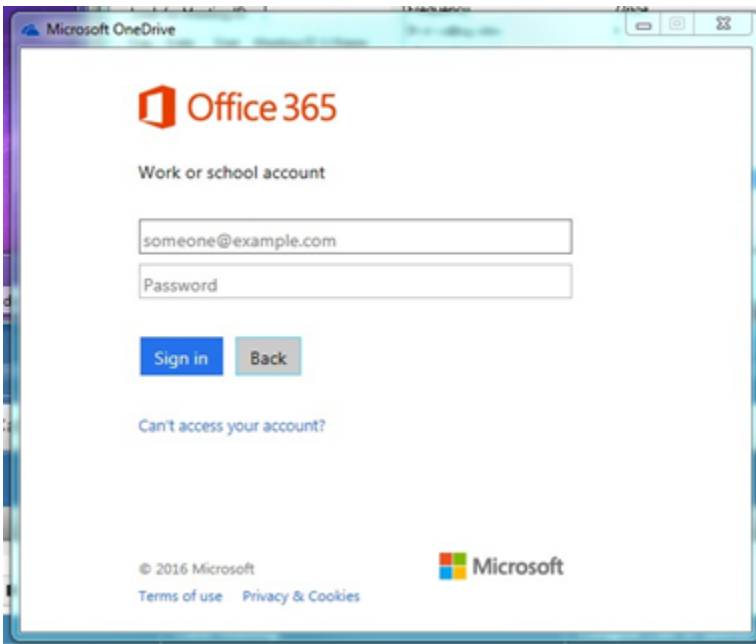
3. You will be asked to enter your WSU email address (*yournetworkid@wsu.edu*).



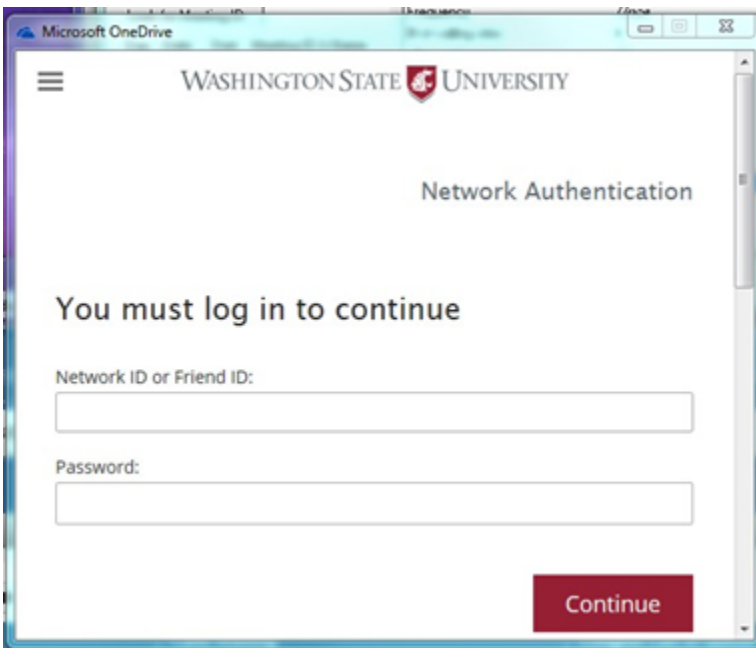
4. Select the button for **Work or School**.



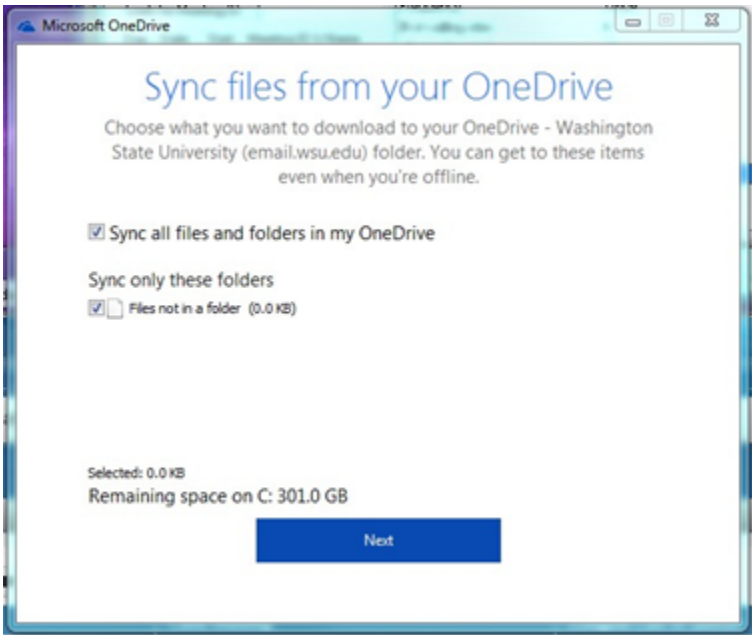
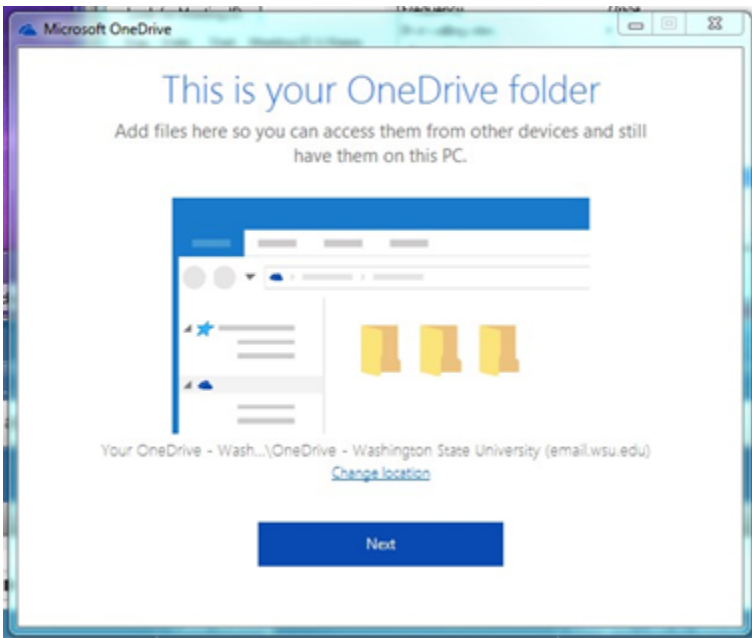
5. Enter your WSU email address to verify your affiliation with WSU.
